INFRASTRUCTURE

Campus :

The institute is in a spacious campus spread over 2.5 acres of land with all modern amenities. The institute presently has well equipped seminar halls, conference hall, state of the art computer centre, microprocessor lab, a well stocked library & the administrative block, canteen. The campus is located in NCR on Delhi-Saharanpur highway just 29km from ISBT and 15 kms from Delhi border and will be 39km from Akshardham Temple through newly built highway.

Computer Centre: The computer centre caters to the computing needs of the students and staff of the institute and training requirement of several computer oriented courses. The centre is fully equipped with following systems:





a) Servers

The Computer center has Intel xeon HP ProLiant DL360 Gen10 Rack mounted Server with 56GB RAM, 4

x 600GB SAS Hard drive, P420 RAID Card, HPE Ethernet 1GB 4Port onboard NIC, and redundant Power Supply. Configured with 5 virtual servers in Microsoft Hyper-V, along with additional storage Server of 8 x 1TB RAID 5 Hard disk.

b) Nodes

The Computer center has equipped with 100 nos. of Pentium I-5 machines, which are connected to the Server through LAN, Center has modern & high tech technological information highway (internet) in use as a tool for working in latest environment. The Computer center kept open for 24hrs. for the practice & development of software skills by our building technocrats.

c) Internet Wi Fi Campus

The Computer center equipped fiber dedicated lease line connectivity of 100 Mbps. Unlimited internet facilities are provided to each and every student with wi-fi connectivity in college campus and hostel.

Lecture Halls :

The college has spacious & ventilated lecture halls, equipped with the latest audio-video equipments to support the theory classes. It has proper seating arrangement.

Central Library :

Syadwad Institute of Higher Education & Research (SIHER) Library was established in 2009 to serve the academic community of the Institute in particular and this region of the state in general. The Library has books of different Dept.'s like: Nursing, Education, Management, Computer Application, B.A., B.Com., Jainism literature, Home Science and other reference Books. The L-Shape type library building is designed on modular pattern. The Library is known as Syadwad Central Library.



Library is well stocked with 10,000+ books. The state of the art library stretching over 3000 square feet, is a domain for information seekers as its students, faculties or researchers. The library is fully ventilated. It has the capacity of 140 students sitting strength at a time. Besides the comfortable seating and reading environment, the library is well equipped with modern facilities and resources in the form of Magazines, CD/DVD ROM, E-journals : NCERT-8, National Journals-13, International Journals-13, Dictionary, Educational Encyclopedia, back volumes of journals etc. Facilities such as 10 Laptops to access internet resources, photocopying, fax, online journals, e-learning are some of the special features. The library has all the facilities for the students to learn. The Library is committed to provide a world-class information support to its users.

Transport Facility :

The institute has its own buses, which are available to the students on nominal charges. All the students are being provided with the transport facilities to commute from the institute to the different locations of Delhi/NCR/Surrounding areas.



Hostel Facility :

DEPARTMENT OF NURSING

Nursing is a profession within the health care sector focused on the care of individuals, families, and communities so they may attain, maintain or recover optimal health and quality of life.

Nurses may be differentiated from other health care providers by their approach to patient care, training and scope of practice. Nurses practice in a wide diversity of practice areas with a different scope of practice and level of prescriber authority in each. Many nurses provide care within the ordering scope of physicians and this traditional role has come to shape the historic public image of nurses as care providers. However, nurses are

permitted by most jurisdictions to practice independently in a variety of settings depending on training level.



"Nursing is the protection, promotion and optimization of health and abilities; prevention of illness and injury; alleviation of suffering through the diagnosis and treatment of human responses and advocacy in health care for individuals, families, communities and populations." - American Nurses Association.



NURSING LABS

Pre-Clinical Science Lab :

The pre clinical science laboratory is designed with the purpose of helping the students to acquire knowledge of the normal structure and function of various human body systems and to identify any deviation from normal health in order to render effective nursing care. The aim of the laboratory is to educate the students to understand the normal body parts with use of models; specimens etc. and to co relate its function. This will enhance the student's ability to understand the various disease conditions.

Nursing Foundation including Adult Health Nursing & Advanced Practice Lab :

This Lab is aimed at helping the students to acquire knowledge, understanding and skills in technique of nursing practice. This lab is well equipped with simulators, CPR mannequins, life

form hand simulator etc. The mannequins with movable limbs and replaceable parts are recipients of a variety of nursing interventions such as- Hand washing methods, Bed making, positioning, injections, intravenous catheters, nasogastric tubes, Foleys catheters, wound care, hair care, vital signs monitoring, various specimen collection, oxygenation therapy, CPR etc.



Nutrition Lab :

Nutrition Lab is equipped with utensils & nutritional charts. It is well ventilated, lighting & adequate water facilities. The students can assess the nutritional needs, caloric requirement of different age groups during various disease conditions.

Community Health Nursing Laboratory :

This laboratory is equipped with sufficient equipments like community bags, IEC items and models. The department actively participates in all national health programmes implemented by Government of India and State government. The field training is imparted in both rural and urban areas..

Obstetrics & Gynaecology Nursing Lab :

Obstetrical lab provide students with an opportunity to learn and develop the skills essential to midwifery practice within a supportive environment. Students are trained in laboratory under the supervision of faculty members to provide them with sufficient experience in dealing with women during the different stages of pregnancy, child birth and during post natal period.

Child Health Nursing Lab :

This lab provides students with a realistic, stimulated clinical environment to practice and demonstrate competency of selected nursing skills. Clinical training in pediatric lab equips students with essential knowledge, skills and attitude needed to provide accurate, safe and comprehensive nursing care for normal child.

Computer & Audio-visual Laboratory :

Computer Lab at nursing college provides a learning atmosphere to the students so that they can acquaint themselves with the computer applications and skills. The lab is fully equipped with fully functional PC's with WI-FI .Computer Lab runs efficiently under the supervision of Computer Instructor, who teaches the student regarding various computer applications and health management information system (HMIS).

In India Integrated Teacher Education Programmed (ITEP) course offered for those interested in processing carrier in teaching. ITEP degree is mandatory for teaching in secondary and senior secondary schools.

Duration: 8 Semesters

Eligibility : Intermediate pass with 50% marks (Arts, Commerce and Science)

Fee : As per Govt. Norms.

Objective : Integrated Teacher Education Programmed (ITEP) is a undergraduate professional degree which prepare students for work a teacher in School.

Career Opportunities : ITEP is a four-year degree program that prepares teachers for the Foundational, Preparatory, Middle, and Secondary stages of the new school structure outlined in the National Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020)

Syllabus :

Student Induction Programme (Common to all student-teachers across stage specific specialisation. To be organised during the first two weeks of Semester-1) Foundation of Education Disciplinary / interdisciplinary Courses Stage-Specific Content - cum - Pedagogy Courses Ability Enhancement and Value-Added Courses School Experience, including internship in Teaching Community Engagement and Service

Multiple Entry and Exit and Re-entry Options : The ITEP envisages multiple entry and exit points and reentry options, with appropriate certifications. Student-teachers who wish to exit after completion of one year (two semesters) of study will be given a Certificate indicating the credits accrued for the courses pursued. Student-teachers who wish to exit after completion of two years (four semesters) will be given a Diploma indicating the credits accrued for the courses completed. Student-teachers who wish to exit after successful completion of three years (six semesters) will be awarded a Bachelor's Degree in the chosen Major area of study upon securing a minimum of 120 credits and satisfying the minimum credit requirements of 48 credits for the Major. Student-teachers who successfully complete four years (eight semesters) of study will be awarded a dual-major bachelor's degree such as B.A.B.Ed. or B.Sc.B.Ed. or B.Com.B.Ed. etc. upon securing a minimum of 160 credits, including a minimum of 80 credits for the first major (i.e. in education), and a minimum of 48 credits for the second major (i.e., in a disciplinary/interdisciplinary area relating to one of the curricular areas in school education).

Nomenclature of Degree Awarded : As the ITEP being a Dual-Major programme with School Stage specialisation, it will lead to the award of one of the following Degrees, depending on the chosen discipline of study and Stage Specific specialisation.
