

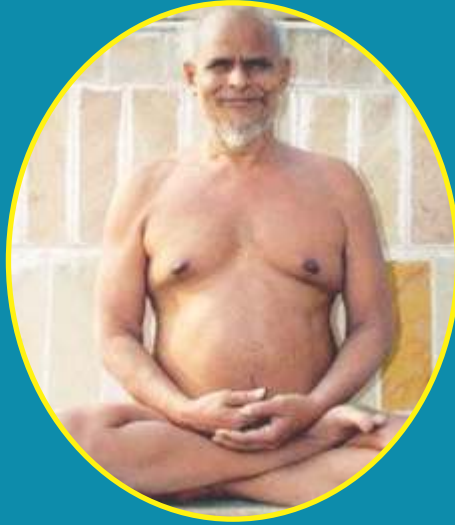

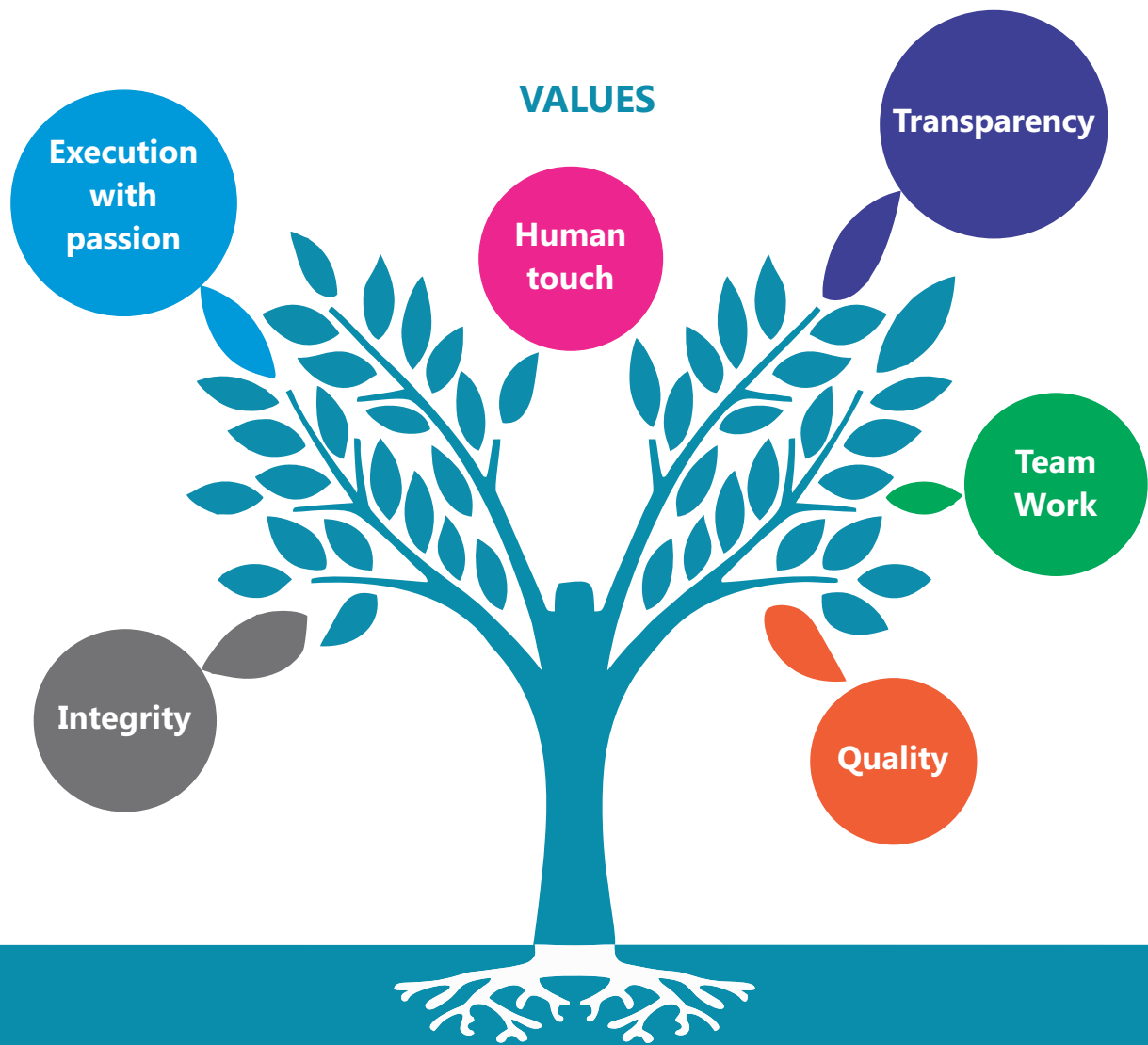

Nurses practice in a wide diversity of practice areas with a different scope of practice and level of prescriber authority in each. Many nurses provide care within the ordering scope of physicians and this traditional role has come to shape the historic public image of nurses as care providers. However, nurses are permitted by most jurisdictions to practice independently in a variety of settings depending on training level.

Infrastructure

Campus

The institute is in a spacious newly constructed campus spread over 2.5 acres of land with all modern amenities. The institute presently has well equipped seminar halls, conference hall, state of the art computer centre, microprocessor lab, a well stocked library & the Administrative block. The campus is located in NCR on Delhi-Saharanpur highway just 29km from ISBT and 15 kms from Delhi border.

Computer Centre

The computer centre caters to the computing needs of the students and staff of the institute and training requirement of several computer oriented courses. The centre is fully equipped with following systems:

a) IT Infrastructure

Institute has DELL Server (Rack Mounted), Storage Server, Campus wide Networking through hybrid system, Managed Switches, Access Points with 100 Systems on Network. Though Institute Electricity is directly from Grid for maximum availability of Power Supply, still we have separate UPS for IT infrastructure.

b) Internet

The computer centre has 8 MBPS Leased lines. Unlimited internet facilities are provided to each and every student. The computer centre is kept open for 24 hours.

Central Library

The institute's library is housed in two wings of the main library. The reference library wing where current periodicals including CD's, Videocassettes etc., their back volume and reference books are displayed for reading within the premises. The library has a collection of about 150 vol. including back volumes of journals. It subscribes to about 30 periodicals on computers and management. It also subscribes to national and International journal on nursing. It has a collection of 3000 E-books also. The library is open till 6.00 p.m. on all week days. Library facilities are also available in the hostel.

Transport Facility

The institute has its own buses, which are available to the students on nominal charges. All the students are being provided with the transport facilities to commute from the institute to the different locations of Delhi/NCR/Surrounding areas.

Hostel Facility

Our objective of establishing hostel as the dream campus is to provide students "a home away from home", wherein they can feel at ease and put in their best efforts for acquiring knowledge, skill and right attitude towards life. The hostel atmosphere certainly provides self confidence, instills discipline in students and also provides scope for developing ideals for a harmonious and communal living. These attributes enable them share the joys of camaraderie, friendship/fellowship and professional fraternity, senior students have been trained to be more responsible and thus set good examples for the juniors. Everyone should uphold the dignity, self respect and reputation of every other student and of the Alma-Mater as a whole. Self - help and spirit of accommodation for the common good are some of the virtues expected from the inmates.

The institute has spacious and well-furnished hostels separately for boys & girls, with all the physical amenities like Geysers, Aqua-Guard, Separate study tables, fans, gas stoves, steel almira, T.V. & other recreational facilities. It is located within the campus itself with all the security arrangements.

Health Centre:

A team of Medical Professionals at Syadwad provides consultation and treatment for common ailments to the students and staff.

Meditation/Spiritual Training

Regular training is provided on meditation and spiritual for providing managers with human touch to the market.

Code of Conduct for Students

- Discipline is the utmost need and prime
- Objective for the betterment and upliftment of college.
- Dress code is compulsory for all the students to abide by it.
